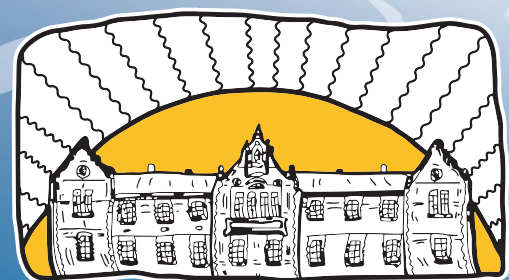

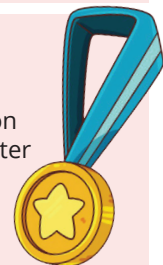

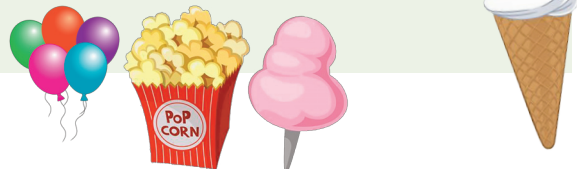
Come one, come all to the greatest show in Pearse St!

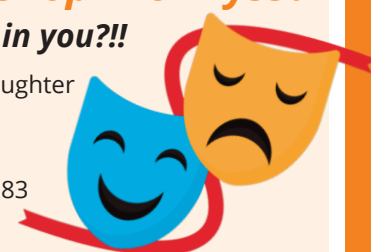
