Frequently Asked Questions

Who can take part in the programme?

Secondary school students who attend local public schools may apply for tuition in the Goldsmith programme. COVID-19 regulations have forced us to suspend, until further notice, some of our other programmes such as the St. Andrew's programme for primary schools.

What happens in the programme?

In previous years, your child would have received one-to-one tuition for one hour each week in their chosen subject(s) from a volunteer tutor from Trinity College, in the Goldsmith Hall on Pearse Street/ Westland Row. Due to COVID-19 regulations, we have had to revise the programme. Your child will now partake in a small group tutoring session with two tutors and a small number of other children, through an online virtual platform such as Zoom.

How will I find out about my child's tutor/ tuition group?

The coordinator of your child's tuition hour will contact you with specific details on your child's tutor/ tuition group, including the day and time that tuition will take place.

What happens next?

Once your child has been assigned to a tuition group, the relevant coordinator will contact you to let you know how to access the tuition sessions each week. If your child cannot attend, please contact the coordinator. This is important, as it is only fair to both other students on the programme and the voluntary tutors giving up their free time to run the programme.

What if my child does not get assigned a tutor/ tuition group?

We try to assign everyone a tutor if at all possible. If you have not heard from us by the time the programme starts, please contact St. Andrew's Resource Centre or email vtp@csc.tcd.ie and we will do our best to accommodate your child.
