On 12 March we were told we had to close our Childcare and Day Centre immediately. Later on, the lockdown meant we had to change the way we deliver all our services. Most staff are working from home. Those who are in the building are observing strict HSE guidelines. Our home care team, providing home help and meals services have ramped up activity, with 170 meals delivered every day. Strict guidelines are being followed to protect staff and clients.

We have linked in with residents around the community who are acting as a point of contact with their neighbours.

The message is simple: we are here for the community, and the community is here for each other. Calls to national helplines, like Alone, from this area are referred to us and we follow up. 
Supporting our Seniors
